Their Need

The area around the building is the site of a major environmental clean-up project at the Hanford Nuclear Power Plant. Hundreds of contractors needed space for long-term projects and the closest office complex was miles distant. Undi Properties purchased land and needed an attractive looking office facility quickly, one which might be relocatable in 10 to 15 years.

Our Solution

Whitley constructed a number of modules to “temporarily” locate, for ten to fifteen years, near the clean up site. Construction of the modules began before the ground had been broken and were set within 45 days and open within 60 days. The pace of construction and development meant the facility could be operating well ahead of competition and insure a quick return on investment capital.
