



Key Bank

Key Bank is a strong national financial institution headquartered in Cleveland, Ohio, and is the 13th largest bank in the USA. It has branches all over the country including many in the Seattle area. Key Bank was the first national retail bank and is one of the largest lenders in home equity, education and recreation.

Their Problem

Their existing structure in the Ballard District of Seattle was inadequate. A new bank was planned as part of a large condo-office complex, but the company needed to continue serving their customers over the two year between demolition of the existing facility and the opening of the new complex. They chose to buy a modular facility to provide continuity to their customers.

Our Solution

Key Bank chose to partner with GE Modular Space who contacted Whitley. Construction began in August of 2005 and was completed a month later on the four module, 2880 square foot building. Much of the interior work, include vault installation, was completed on site and the bank was open in plenty of time to maintain service continuity. Key has already order a second building to solve a similar need in another part of Seattle.
