



Homestead High School

Located on the west suburbs of Fort Wayne, Homestead is a large high school with premier programs in football, soccer and marching band. It is also a leader in academics in Indiana.

Their Need

Homestead is one of the fastest growing school systems in the state. They have sports facilities that would be the envy of many colleges and some universities. Homestead needed to develop a practice field which could double as a secondary competition field and a home for their marching band. It needed to be comfortable for observers, as well as for event participants.

Our Solution

A large press box was placed on top of a bleacher system that would seat over 1,000 persons. The press box provides plenty of counter space for news organizations, as well as for athletic managers, coaches, observers and activity analysts. The press box has a large camera deck atop the building to allow unobstructed video perspectives. The heating and air conditioning system is designed to handle humid Indiana summers and winter blizzards, not to mention keeping the windows fog-free for observation and analysis. The building will remain low-maintenance for many years to come and look beautiful as well.
