## The Challenge

### Quick Deployment + Quality

The homeless transition campus is a pilot test for King County to see if modular buildings are a way to combat the problem of homelessness in the King County area and be able to move the campus to areas around the city with higher demand if need be. The overall building needed to be able to accommodate the needs of both staff and tenants as well as being designed in a way that would allow for durability if it was to be moved to another location later in the buildings life.



## The Solution

### Experience + Quality

With a tight timeline and in the midst of a pandemic Whitley Evergreen was able to deliver all buildings on site within 2 weeks of notification from the King County Government. In addition to this, all buildings were set by April 4, 2020 meeting all deadlines and ensuring that the building could open sooner to meet the demands of the homeless within King County.
